Awareness and Training

- Take all measures that are reasonably practicable to:

 - Re-use waste where it is safe and practicable to do so;
 - Recycle items of waste where possible;
 - Dispose of final wastes by the most environmentally suitable means with none going to landfill;
 - Limit the use of packaging materials and unnecessary materials;

• Adopt the practice of responsible energy management through reduced consumption and the encouragement of energy efficiency throughout the business;

Water

• Aim to reduce water use by measuring consumption and analysing what can be done to reduce it.

Development

- Work with property developers and landlords to find innovative solutions that satisfy our environmental objectives.
